

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PICKAWAY COUNTY PY 2019 CDBG CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM**

Pickaway County intends to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The CDBG program is a federally-funded program administered by the State of Ohio. The County will hold a public hearing on June 4, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. in the Pickaway County Commissioners' Office, 139 West Franklin Street, Circleville, Ohio. The hearing is to give citizens an adequate opportunity to review and comment on the proposed CDBG Program grant application before the County submits the application to the Ohio Development Services Agency on or before June 14, 2019.

Pickaway County will be applying for \$283,700 in PY 2019 CDBG Critical Infrastructure Program funds. Circleville has committed \$112,400 as matching money towards the project. All work proposed for the grant will be carried out between September 1, 2019, and August 31, 2021. The project under consideration includes:

Total reconstruction of Turner Drive, consisting of: approximately 592 LF. of storm sewer, 1,270 LF. of curb and gutter, 375 LF. of sidewalk, 630 LF. of street resurfacing and 630 LF. of new waterline, fire hydrant and 17 watertaps. The project meets the National Objective of benefitting residents residing in Census Tract 020400 Block Group 2, which is 64% Low-Moderate Income per the U.S. Census Data.

Citizens are encouraged to attend this meeting in order to comment on the County's proposed 2019 CDBG Program grant application.
